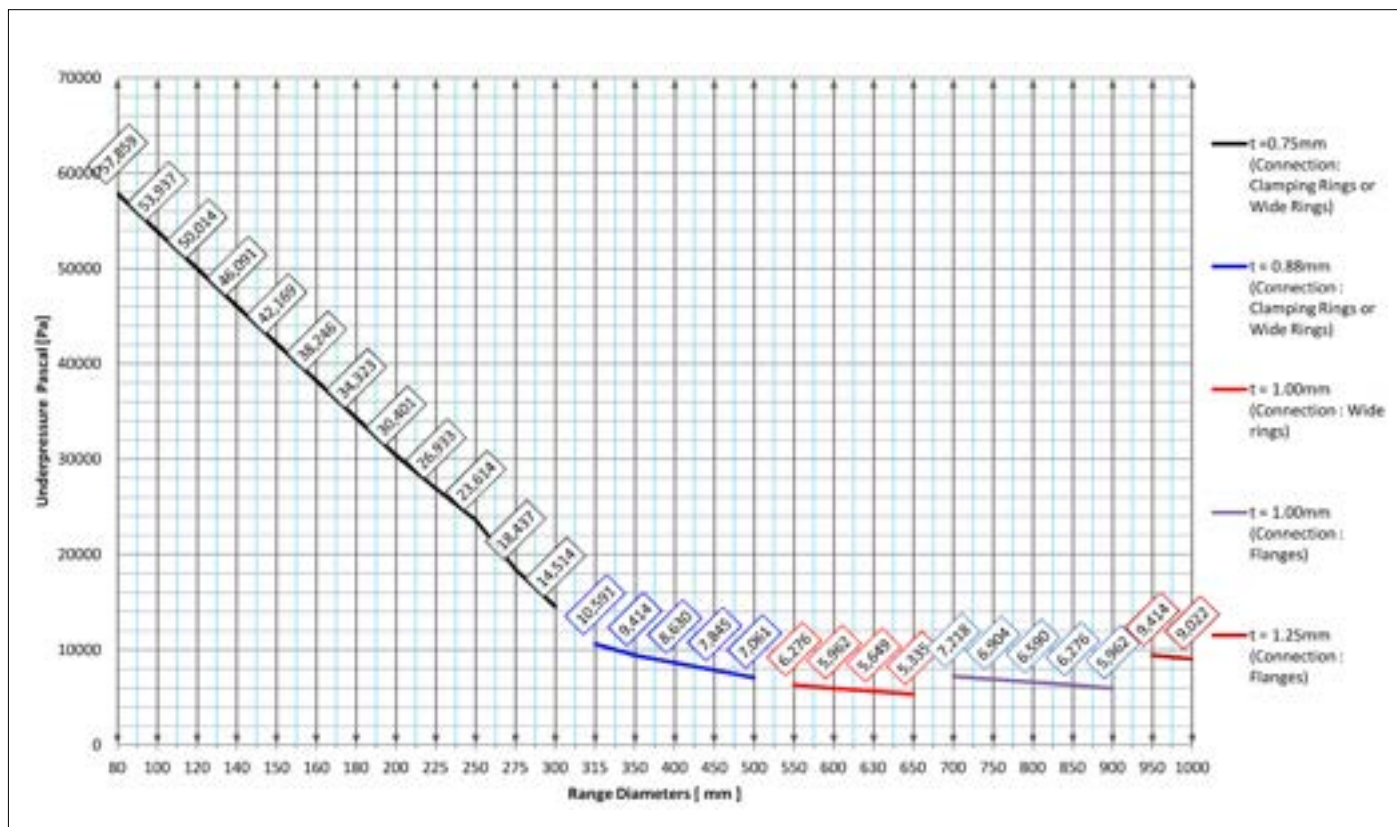

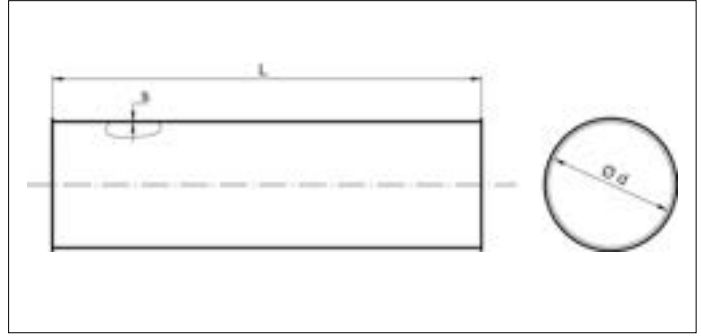
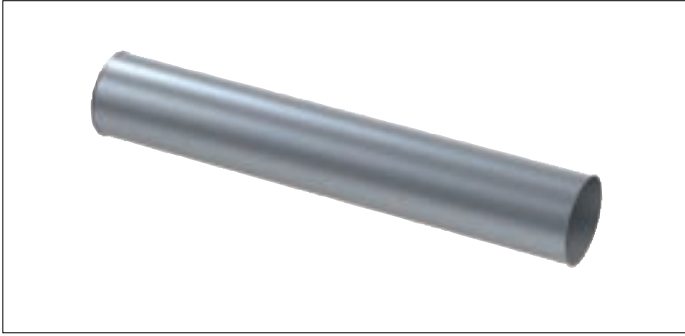
AAAA Laser welded pipes - 2000 mm

Telescope pipes

Telescope pipes are standard longitudinally welded with a stitch-welder for use in overpressure, under-pressure and pressureless systems.

It is assembled in combination with a standard pipe (AAAA) and a rapid-lock ring with seal for telescope pipe (GAAS), both sold separately.

The regulating length is from +20 mm to +450 mm.

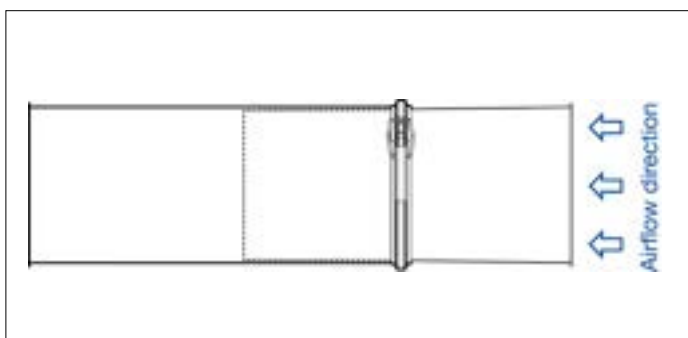

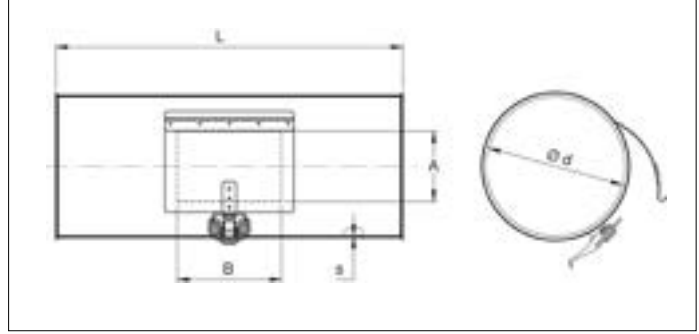

Inspection pipes

Inspection pipes are longitudinally spot-welded or welded with a stitch-welder for use in under-pressure and pressureless systems.

The inspection door is always produced with an inner plate for a smooth inner surface inside the pipe and a foam seal is applied along the edge of the opening to insure airtightness.

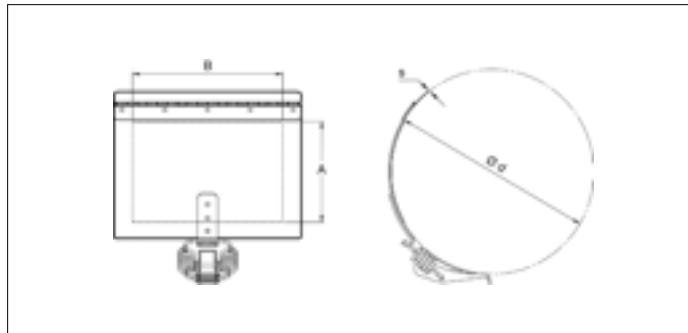


Inspection doors type 'D' with locking mechanism

The inspection door is always produced with an inner plate for a smooth inner surface of the pipe.

Designed to be mounted on straight elements, no curved or conical components. Keep in mind that a seal needs to be applied along the edge of the opening to insure airtightness.

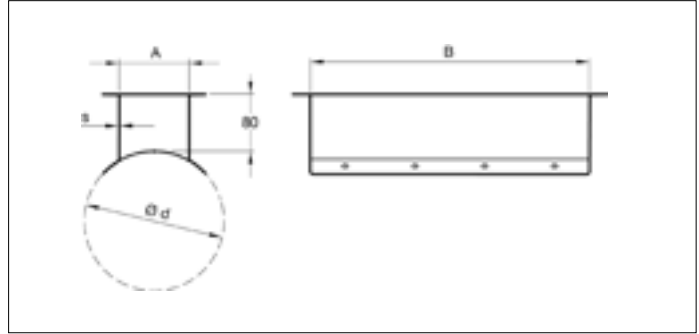


Inspection doors type 'NFX' with loose lid

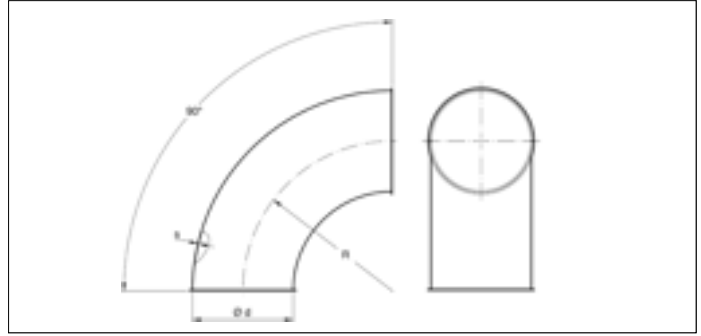

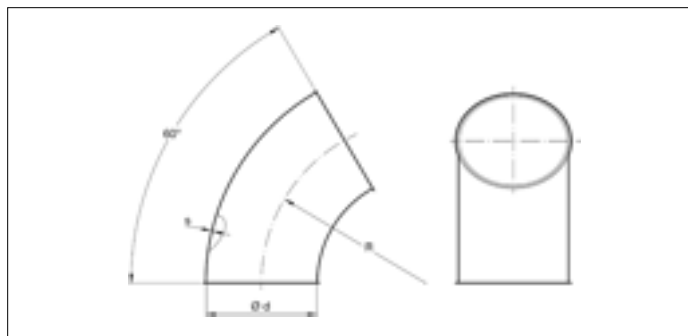

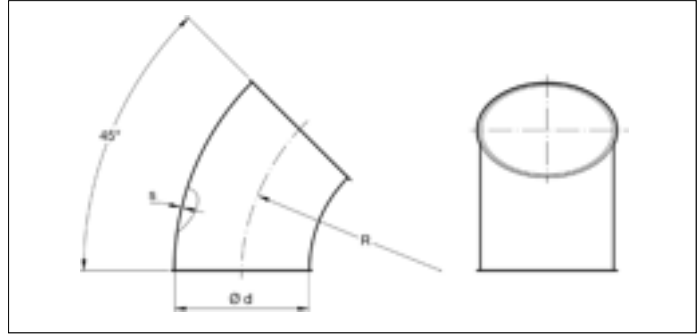

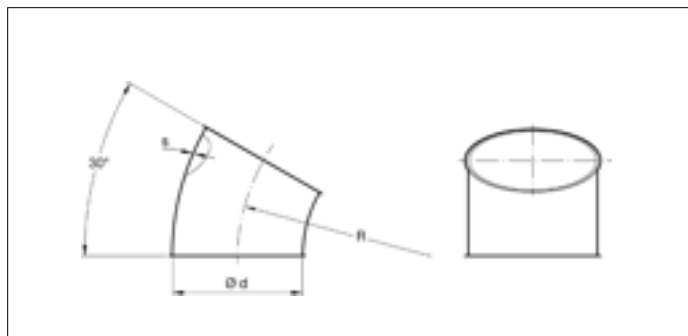

AABA Segmented bends 90° R=1.5D



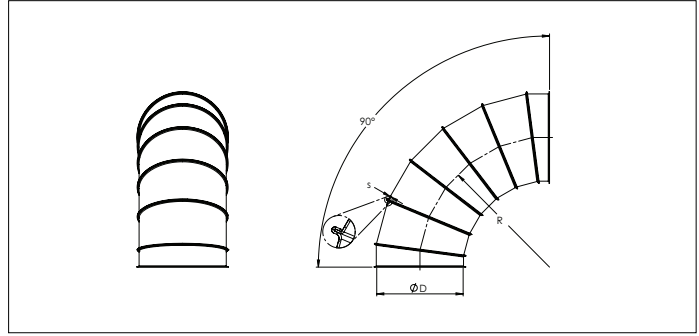
Segmented bends 90° R=1.5D

The segmented bends are composed of stitch-welded segments that are lock-formed together for use in under-pressure and pressureless systems.

As of diameter Ø 225 mm and larger, the intermediate segments are 15°.

These bends are suitable for the transport of waste materials such as dust and chips but also for the transport of grains and such.

They are produced in R=1.5D but other radii are available on request.

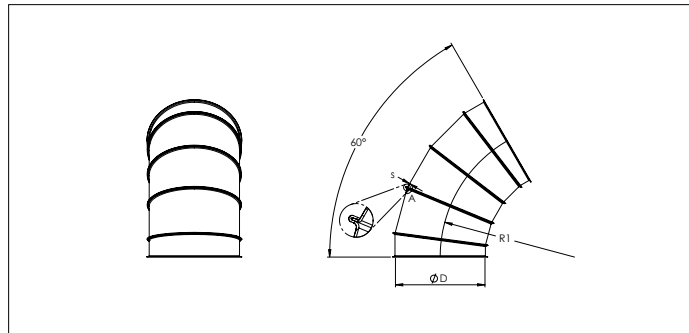

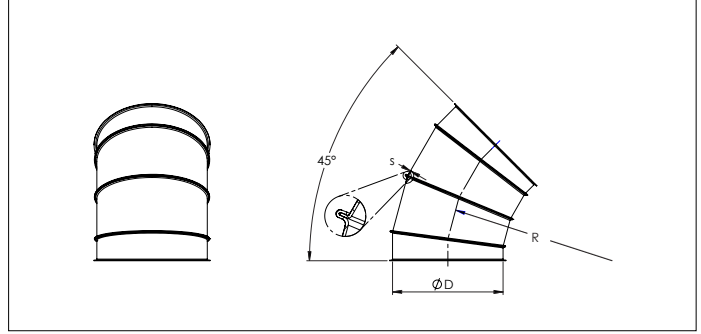

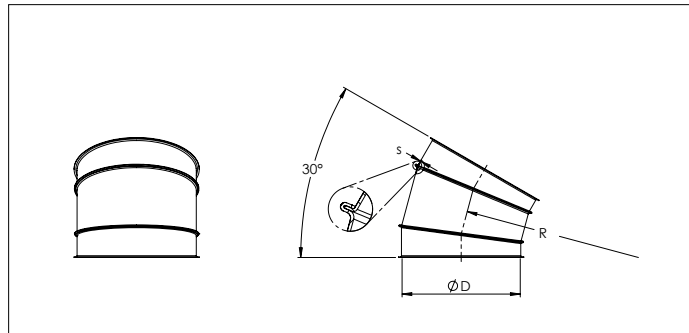

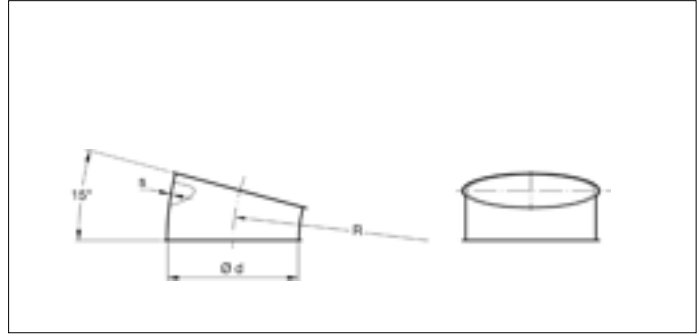

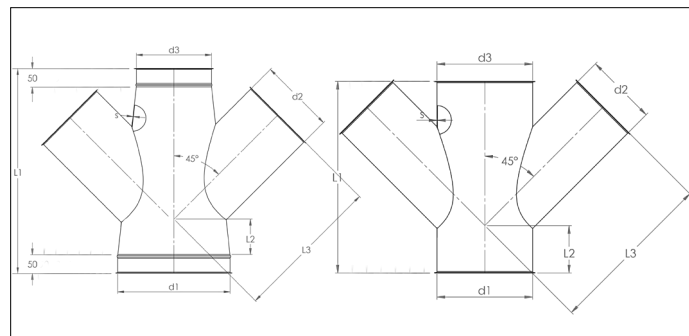

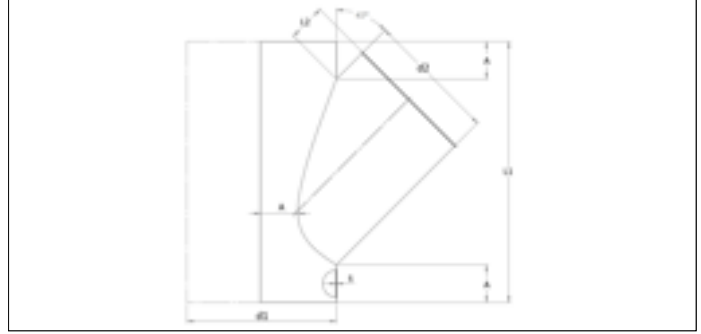

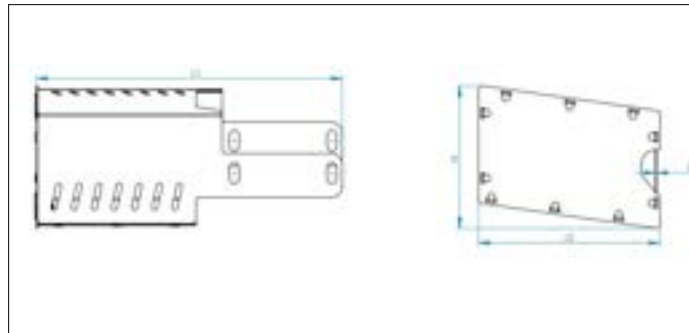

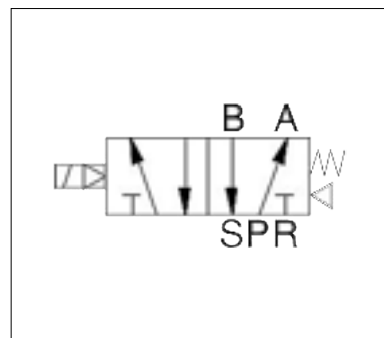

Visual indicator mounted on axle to indicate throttle valve position



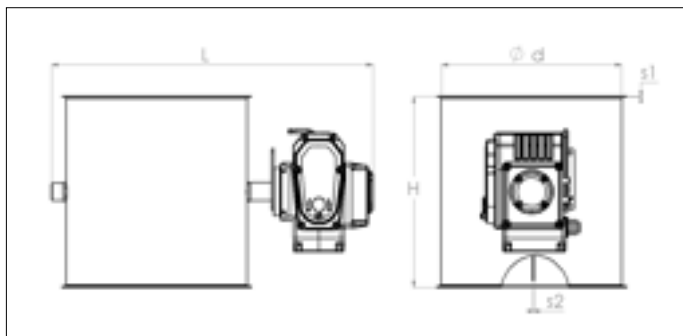

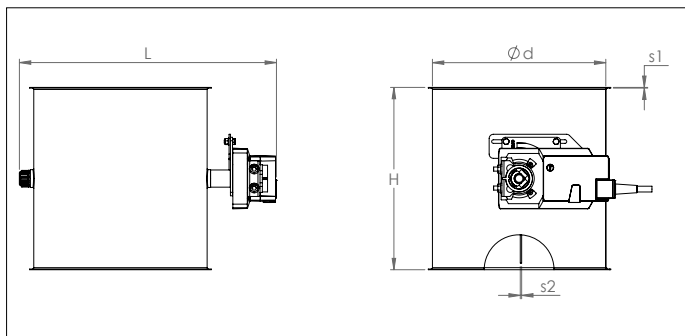

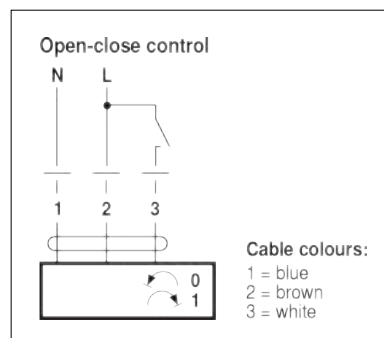

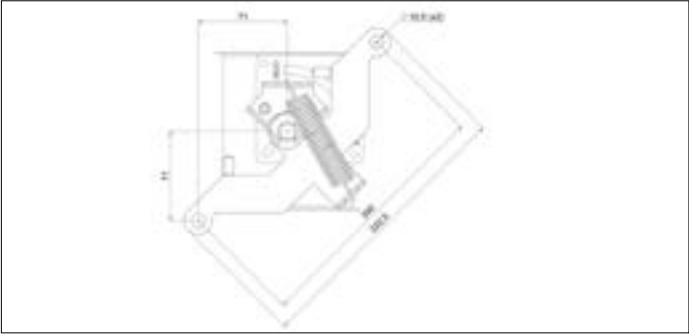
